Within the ongoing requirements to meet affordability and city code standards, our Habitat makes every effort to incorporate green standards in our construction. Currently, all the homes we build are ENERGY STAR-rated, which means they meet strict energy efficiency guidelines set by the EPA and U.S. Department of Energy.

Our Habitat for Humanity affiliate, serving the San Fernando and Santa Clarita valleys, is a strong partner with the Million Tree Project. We have partnered with Pacoima Beautiful in its family education programs. Our goal is to ensure that the common areas are kept as green as possible, regardless of space restrictions in our cities. Families are provided with resources to obtain trees and other plants, along with the education necessary to successfully care for their environment.

Habitat projects are particularly sound in terms of meeting reuse standards. Protocols are in place to capture construction surplus, and to use it to produce cost savings and landfill abatement.

In short, being green is part of our culture. This is a new Habitat for the 21st century.
